### Eyre Peninsula clubs to receive sports funding

Sport and recreation clubs on the Eyre Peninsula and in the western region will benefit from State Government grants totalling \$20,634.

Recreation and Sport Minister Leon Bignell said the clubs had successfully applied for Round 40 of the Active Club Program.

“The funding will be used by these clubs for new programs and equipment,” Mr Bignell said.

“Sport clubs play a central role in the health and welfare of communities and the Active Club Program helps them deliver valuable programs and services.”

#### **Clubs in the region to receive funding include:**

- \$2,500 Charlton Cricket Club Port Lincoln Incorporated
- \$3,500 Eyre Gymnastics Club Incorporated
- \$4,200 The Port Lincoln Tennis Association Incorporated
- \$4,235 The Whyalla Football League Incorporated
- \$3,699 Tumby Bay and District Colts Cricket Club Incorporated
- \$2,500 West Whyalla Cricket Club Incorporated

In total, 159 clubs across the state have been offered recreation and sport funding of \$571,733 for programs and equipment.

Minister Bignell said round 41 of the Active Club Program opens on February 13 and closes on April 11, 2016.

“I encourage local sporting organisations to apply for funding,” he said.
